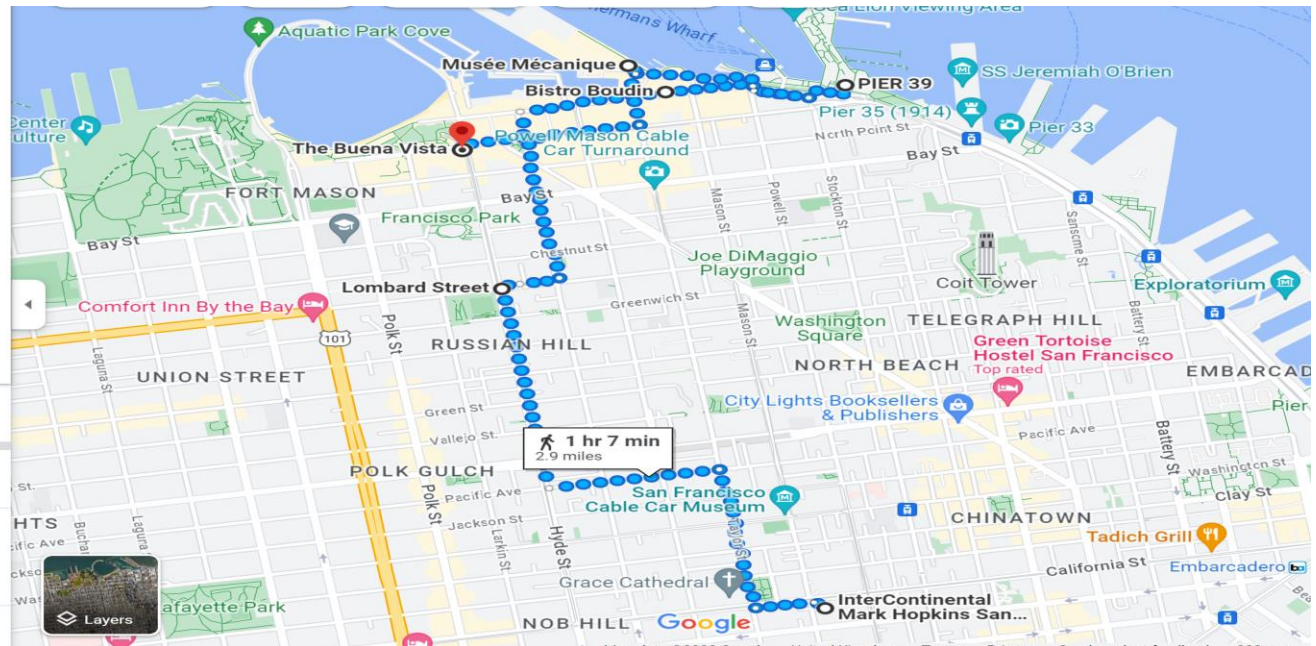

	Things to see	Don't miss the wartime sweethearts' rooftop bar
<b>2. Nob Hill and Russian Hill</b>	Things to see	Mansions traditional rows of houses in bright colours and tiny restaurants.
<b>3. Lombard street</b>	Location	Russian Hill
	Things to see	The steepest, most crooked street in the land with 8 hairpin turns and a 27% gradient.
<b>4. Breakfast at Boudin Sourdough Bakery &amp; Café</b>	Location	Fisherman's Wharf
	Address	160 Jefferson St- between Mason and Taylor Sts
	Things to try	Bread still made from a mother dough first cultivated here in 1849
<b>5. Sealion Spotting</b>	Location	K dock – sealion viewing area, Pier 39, Fisherman's Wharf
	Things to see	Thousands of sealions (not June and July)
<b>6. Pier 39 Victorian arcade</b>	Location	Fisherman's Wharf
	Things to see	A 1970's 2-storey board-walked replica of a Victorian shopping arcade with eateries and fairground rides.
<b>7. Heart sculpture</b>	Location	Fisherman's Wharf
	Things to do	Take an I heart SF selfie
<b>8. Musee mecanique</b>	Location	Fisherman's Wharf
	Address	Pier 45, San Francisco, CA 94133

	Things to see	The world's largest (and creepiest?) privately owned collections of coin-operated mechanical musical instruments and antique arcade artifacts.

	Things to do	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check out the Dragon gate and lantern festooned streets</li> <li>• Try some Chinese food</li> </ul>
<b>13. Drinks at the Fairmont tiki bar</b>	Location	Nob Hill
	Address	950 Mason St, San Francisco, CA 94108
	Things to do	Have a cocktail in an historical tiki bar where a tropical rainstorm crashes from the ceiling every 30 minutes, and a ban strikes up on a boat on the indoor swimming pool.
<b>14. Golden Gate bridge</b>	Location	Golden Gate Bridge Welcome Centre, (Presidio Park) Coastal Trail, San Francisco, CA 94129, United States
	Things to do	<p>Drive/ cycle or stroll over it.</p> <p>There is a pull in area on the other side for driver photographers.</p>
